- Why do we have to talk to ourselves or to other people about our pain?
Answer: because we don't know what to do with it.
- We seek heaven through people, power and possessions, but that kind of imaginary heaven will always betray us.
- The truth is not hard on who you are, it is hard on who you are not.
- Identification does not prove individuality. Instead it proves separateness.
- We are on Earth to go through a very deliberate process of awakening.
- One of the big problems in our relationships with others is that we do not know -- are not aware of the fact -- that other people suffer. Except for rare instances we don't want to know anything about another person's pain. The other person's pain IS your pain. Awareness of that fact is how you love your neighbor as yourself.
- It is consciousness itself that is suffering, and that suffering can only be transcended by accepting it.
- There are three lines to genuine spiritual work: Work on oneself, work with others, and work in service to the world.
- You are the one you have been waiting for. The authentic love we are seeking has been in the consciousness all along, but we have been disconnected from it.
- We are actually very fortunate whenever we come to the end of something that no longer works. Then we never have to go down that same road again.
- Real lessons are not intellectual. A real lesson is the integration of two levels of consciousness.
- The world does not have any hope without genuine spiritual work. As long as there is conflict there can never be love.
- The life that fear is trying to protect is fear's life, not your life.
