Talk Takeaways

- The kind of peace that can so easily be turned into conflict is not genuine peace.
- When it comes to our spiritual life, there is nothing more important than "location, location, location," which is the place where we invest our attention, time and energy.
- There is a psychological location within us where there is perfect peace. That location of perfect peace will never be found in the outer world.
- Peace for humanity now is a state in which there is nothing that is interrupting its dream or interfering with its desire.

- The real root source of conflict is in our present level of consciousness, not on the battlefield outside of us.
- We can't live in the world that we want without at the same time living in world that we don't want. The world that we want, and the world that we don't want, are formed in imagination.
- When we do not get what we imagine we need in order to be at peace, then there is war.
- It is always the weakest part of you that looks for others outside of you for confirmation.
- Instead of trying to find peace, understand the part of you that is always ready to go to war. All warfare is based on deception.
- Conflict is inevitable when your identity is a derivative of imagination.
- Awareness of the temptation to go to war opens up the opportunity to not participate in it. Real intelligence will not hurt itself.
- Peace will never be found by the consciousness that imagines what peace is and therefore has expectations about how events should unfold. That is the world in which war is peace.
- If we could see that the outer world is first a reflection of humanity's interior life, then we would be less likely to be deceived into entering into any conflict, outer or inner.
