Key Lesson: Into what do we gaze when looking through telescope or microscope...other than into the yet discovered depths of our own consciousness? For whatever world we explore – inwardly or outwardly – what is it we uncover there...other than its reflection within us, along with a corresponding knowledge of it; and, if true, where does this new – yet (evidentially) regained – higher level of understanding await us...other than within a timeless order of (our own) consciousness awakened to itself, and made newly self-aware.

- You cannot exist without the food of impressions. The soul hungers for spiritual impressions.
- In order to start having a broader experience, we need a new way to see life.
- We are created to be aware of what is reflected in our consciousness, and to know it as part of what we already are.
- The more wholly that something is seen, the more complete is the experience.
- The one behind the mirror is the one who sees and realizes that the observer and the observed are one thing.

- When your attention is seized by one particular thing, that one thing becomes the whole of your reality.
- What you see and what you are... is a singularity.
- The consciousness that perceives something is there before the thing that it perceives.
- We are not after a world where there is no temptation, but rather we want to be a part of a world that is aware of temptation.
- Love is our effortless attention to whatever we bring into our awareness for the sake of fulfilling that love.
- Reactions are not just calling for you to DO something, they are first and foremost calling for you to SEE something.
- Before you do what the reaction tells you to do, be a student of the reaction.
- There is no psychological fear without negative imagination.
- To grow spiritually means that there is more of you united in attending to what you are aware of.
- Every form of identification is also a form of self-love.
