- The consciousness that sees everything as being outside of itself cannot be kind and it does not know anything about love.
- There does exist a higher order of love that has nothing in common with the world's definition of love.
- Real love does not have anything to do with being tolerant, and it has nothing to do with pretense or compulsion. The world's definition of love is a social contrivance based on an image of what love is supposed to look like.
- In reality we cannot contrive to know real love, but we can stop doing to others what we would not want done to ourselves.

- Perfect love casts out fear. The casting out of fear begins with the awareness of the consciousness that is compelled to keep itself in place. That consciousness is the source of fear.
- To be fearless is not to think about yourself as being a fearless person. We are not the source, the creators of what is true, fearless, wise and loving.
- Higher love is not about affirming our consciousness, but instead it is connected to illuminating, revealing the content of our consciousness. It is an integration of the observer and the observed.
- We have fallen asleep within the level of consciousness that sees itself as being different from everything it sees. This is the source of suffering.
- Real love is about consciously suffering the loss of the self that divides itself out from the moment. Love is the unification of what seems to be separate.
- The actual meaning of "charity" in scripture is "agape," which is love actualized. In love actualized, there is no thinking about what is missing.
- There is boredom when all we have to think about is ourselves.
- Love always encourages from the inside-out.
- The consciousness that clings to what we think we need to be fearless is the source of fear.
- Stress and anxiety is connected to the rush to complete ourselves.
- Trying to mould others into what we believe they need to be is proof of the absence of love.
- There is no light in ambition, only something that calls itself the light that compels us to chase after what it says we need to be whole and loving.

- We are never meant to be outside of love actualized, where fear cannot dwell.
- Being a different human being begins with revealing what love is NOT.
- It hurts to have an enemy, but there is a consciousness that does not want to be conscious of how much pain it is in.
- Knowledge about love and the self that strives to possess that knowledge must continually be sacrificed in order to have a real relationship with love actualized.
