- The very longing to understand is coming from a part of us that already does understand. The answers that we have been looking for are in us already. Within us already exists the fulfillment of our destiny.
- Every gift we receive from the Divine is a hint of the nature of the Giver.
- "I am the Vine and ye are the branches." The greater gives birth to the lesser. Whatever appears in time comes from what is invisible and timeless.
- Who and what we are awaits us in another order of time. Faith is the ability to see the fact of this in scale.
- A moment of seeing and feeling real beauty transcends thought.
- A human being who is awakening does not need belief because their very being itself is a gift that is connected to what is real and eternal and already complete.
- See and feel the depth of what you are looking at. The world is dedicated to seeing that human beings no longer have any relationship to the depth of anything real. Consciously explore the depth of every kind of state that passes through you. As an exercise, practice feeling the depth of what you see.

- We don't presently see, instead we think. And thinking will never be connected to being.
- Fear belongs to time. Fear belongs to people trying to take something from this world, instead of understanding that they have already been given everything they need to fulfill their destiny.
- There is nothing more shallow than an identity derived from a negative reaction.
- We can't have a belief without an image, and the image itself contains false consolation and creates a dependency on an authority outside of ourselves.
