Key Lesson: We cannot change ourselves by actions in fractions, any more than we can transform sour milk into sweet cream by removing one soured curd at a time. Either the whole of us changes, or not. Seeing ourselves in the mirror of the Divine is not an achievement arrived at by imagining unity one piece at a time. Our true self is not its individual parts, but rather the sum of all that we are...now and forever more.

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Talk Takeaways

- Whenever something in you says "I can't," what is really behind that is "I won't."
- The nature that never wants to meet its limitations will filter out anything that does not conform to its image of itself.
- We are meant to be more than we presently are. Our present sense of self doesn't satisfy us. We have a longing for something higher so we might be elevated into a new experience, which is a new understanding.

- "Watchfulness is the path to immortality. Unwatchfulness is the path to death. Those who are watchful never die. Those who are unwatchful are already dead." – Upanishads
- "The light of the body is the eye. If therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light." -- New Testament
- That which illuminates the body is the faculty of self-understanding. Therefore if that understanding is single, then the body will become transparent from the inside out because it is being illuminated that way. In that relationship is something that does not die.
- Revelation is not static. There is no moment that isn't a living, fluid expression of all that is living and dying and being reborn. Revelation is a ceaselessly unfolding manifestation of a celestial reaction.
- We live with an unseen filter that sits between us and real life, and that filter is the consciousness that judges the moment and then acts accordingly.
- Watchfulness is the same as being a conscious participant in creation.
- The self's experience of life is what interferes with the whole experience of real life. The self that experiences the moment is inseparable from the moment it experiences.
- Judging yourself for what you see is not watchfulness. That consciousness hides itself by judging itself.
- You cannot separate your life from the conditions that reveal it.
- Listen without talking to yourself. See without interpreting what you see.
- The hatred of something dark within you does not prove that you are full of light.
- I accept all that I'm given to see by Thee, outwardly as well as inwardly, peacefully. Not my will, but Thy Will be done.
- Useless suffering is the rejection of revelation. You stop suffering when you'd rather SEE it all than BE any of it.
