Talk Takeaways

- There cannot be a bridge without awareness of the opposing shore and the need to reach that shore. A bridge connects possibilities.
- True spiritual lessons come along when you don't really want them. Revelations of the unwanted kind.
- The resistance of revelation is reincarnation. Revelation of what has been concealed allows a healing to take place.
- Hell is the endless attempt to rescue yourself.
- There is a will that does not want to do what you know is good, and instead does the evil you would not want to do.
- The temptation to pursue freedom in a time to come is hope in things seen. Faith includes seeing the pain and futility of that temptation.

- Anger belongs to a consciousness that does not know what to do with the pain that it is in.
- Awareness of the pain of trying to be what you believe you need to be is the first glimpse of the other shore.
- "Not my will, but Thy Will be done" is a bridge of connection between a lower level and a higher level of consciousness.
- You cannot change what you have become unless you become aware of it.
- The unattended mind is the breeding ground of self-defeat. You would not intentionally consent to self-defeat, and yet that is what takes place when our attention does not belong to us.
- The bridge between what is revealed, and that which reveals it, is already there in place.
- Why is there judgment in the awareness of contrast? The big picture that we have the potential to see would not exist without contrast.
- We are always separate from whatever the mind is analyzing, which actually keeps us from really knowing all about what is being analyzed.
