- In any moment that you see beauty, you are not searching for anything to complete yourself.
- The world tells us that the way to complete ourselves is through acquisition, achievement and approval.
- We spend almost our entire lives trying to find the "partner of the moment" to complete us. Every partner we imagine has to be re-imagined when it doesn't live up to what we thought it would be.
- Our entire life can be spent in time uselessly looking outside of ourselves for what is timeless.

- There is already a partner in your life that exists to show you all of the false partners that you imagine you need to set you free.
- All false partners temporarily satisfy the one who imagines them, providing a strong sense of self. False partners are conjured up from the past, imagination, thought.
- Whenever you win a battle in this world, in imagination, you immediately find yourself back on the battlefield fighting again.
- You are invited to a wedding, but your problem is that you think you are the guest of honor. The wedding is not in your honor. The wedding is intended for you to honor that which has invited you to the wedding and that which "marries" you to the right partner.
- Whenever you judge someone else, you are exalting yourself at the same time.
- It is the pain that doesn't want to know itself that imagines a time to come in which it will be free of pain, where everything will be perfect.
- You are in the right place when you realize that there is only one place you need to be in each and every moment.
- The endless reconciliation and transformation of all creation requires that every creation submit to that which reveals, reconciles, and transforms.
- You have the capacity to understand the purpose of resistance and to use it in order to serve the Good, as opposed to being the captive of resistance and serving only yourself.
- A part of us is terrified to live without the false partners that we have relied on up until now.
- Consistent, endless submissiveness to the light that reveals the unconscious nature is the wedding that we are invited to.

- Exercise: The new struggle is to see the useless struggle in trying to keep your life in place. See the parts of you that do not want to submit. Stop looking for partners and start seeing that you already have one. Stop looking, start seeing.
