Start Seeing and Being Part of a New Creation

Key Lesson: It isn't your moment... unless you like doing time; real Life is a single movement. Whatever stirs you is a portion of the dance; whatever you hear is a single line from a verse or song with neither beginning nor end. Even these hints about heaven have already moved along. Creation is unceasing, so don't linger; for whatever seems to be here... isn't.

Talk Takeaways

- Without direct experience, all we have is the pretense of life.
- "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new." -- New Testament
- A person begins to seek real freedom when they finally begin to be weary of false freedom.
- Sleeping human beings poison every single person who looks at them. Seeing this kind of fact awakens the will to not participate in, nor contribute to, that kind of life.
- The light shows you at once who you have been, as well as what it is possible for you to be.
- The old nature does not really look for a new life. Instead, it only looks for something that will make it FEEL new, so that it doesn't have to really change.

- People become satisfied with being dissatisfied with their lives. Dissatisfaction becomes a human being's pleasure.
- We cannot do what is new and true until we cease doing what is old.
- It is our purpose as human beings to take part in creation. Anything that is taking part in creation is itself new. False purpose is to act as if you are the creator.
- The forces that move through nature are representations of the forces that move through consciousness. Inside of you lives those forces, those currents.
- It is impossible to know contentment in the world outside of yourself until you know contentment in the world within yourself.
- There is no personality formed out of an action that is truly practical.
- Every resource needed to be a participant in creation is already present within you. On the other hand, there is something in us that is opposed to anything new.
- Whatever is new does not come with familiarity, but it does come with a vague recognition of being your true home, to which you are called to return.
- What you don't see can't change. The observation of something changes the nature of what is observed.
- When you really see something, you are not comforted by having seen it. Most of what we call seeing is the mind comforting itself over what it has seen by thinking about a principle that explains it.
- The real moment of seeing anything is a moment of creation. The moment of creation is a disturbance, but the disturbance is already being reconciled the moment it appears.
- As long as you are never wrong, you will never know what it is like to be a part of creation.
- Become the observer of your own negative state instead of the unconscious instrument of it. The state and the self that embraced the state will be changed at the same time.
